CIRCULAR

Competition Commission of India (CCI) vide its D.O. Letter No. 481/Chairman/CCI/2020/1933 dated 19th February, 2020 has referred to the Competition Commission of India Act, 2002 with emphasis on Section 19(1)(b) of the Act.

- 2. The Section 19(1)(b) of the Act stipulates that Government or its Enterprises may refer any case of suspected bid-rigging that may come to light during procurement process in the organisation.
- 3. In the interest of the organisation, all officials are directed that if any alleged case/incident of bid-rigging comes to their notice during the procurement process, the same may be referred immediately to the Chief Vigilance Officer, ITPO for necessary action in assisting CCI in detecting anti-competitive conduct and ascertaining violation of law.
- 4. This issues with the approval of the CVO.
