CMD, ITPO INAUGURATES NEWLY CONSTRUCTED HOSTEL OF INSTITUTION FOR BLIND AT PANCHKUIAN ROAD, NEW DELHI

In response to the request of Institution for Blind, he also announced that ITPO would construct one portion of old building of the blind school. It was a proud moment for all ITPO's employees for taking up such an ambitious project for the benefit of the society at large, he added. He also appreciated NBCC for the support in construction of the hostel block and the renovated toilet block.

During the year 2015-16, realizing the plight of the blind students at the Institution, Shri L.C. Goyal, CMD, ITPO had decided to contribute Rs. 52 lakh towards the construction of a Hostel Block Building (G+1 floors) for the blind students at the Andh Vidyalaya, Panchkuian Road. The 'Foundation Stone' for the said Hostel Block was laid by Shri Goyal, on February07, 2017.

Expressing his heartiest gratitude towards ITPO for a newly constructed hostel and renovated toilet facilities, Shri Sunil Khurana, President, Institution for Blind informed that mostly the "Divyang" students belonged to economically backward, rural families and that there is no dearth of talent among them. The newly constructed Hostel Block (G+2 floors) can accommodate around 60 blind students residing at the Institute with a separate toilet facility on each floor.
